33rd Annual PLASTIC CLASSIC REGATTA and CONCOURS D'ELEGANCE *SATURDAY, JULY 15th, 2017*

From 10:00 until dusk at the Bay View Boat Club (Pier 54) and the waters off Pier 54. Trophy presentation and party at the Bay View Boat Club after 18:00. ONLY BOATS ENTERED IN THE CONCOURS WILL BE ALLOWED TO TIE TO THE BVBC DOCKS.

NOTICE OF RACE

1.0 RULES This race shall be governed by the current USSA Racing Rules of Sailing.

2.0 CHANGES TO THE RULES RRS # 29.2, #35, #A4.2 are changed and the changes shall be published in full in the Sailing Instructions.

3.0 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1 Eligible vessels are ALL sailing vessels designed 25 or more years ago and made of "Plastic". Separate starts will be given to each class with five or more entrants. There will also be PHRF divisions.

3.2 All entries must be received by July 7th. Entries received after this date are late and must have a late entry fee included in addition to the regular entry fee. The fees are; Regatta, \$35.00, Concourse d'Elegance, \$20.00, Regatta and Concourse, \$50.00. FOR LATE ENTRY FEE, add \$10.00 to other fees.

3.3 Members of US Sailing Association may deduct \$5.00 from their fee if they include a copy of their current USSA membership card.

4.0 SCHEDULE The first Warning signal shall be at 1300.

5.0 HANDICAPS

5.1 All vessels must have a valid PHRF certificate from YRA of San Francisco Bay OR be of a design that has a YRA PHRF certificate on file and match the qualifications of that certificate OR have a BVBC assigned handicap.

5.2 For PHRF scoring **time on time** shall be used.

5.3 Six seconds per mile will be added for non-spinnaker.

6.0 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS The SI's shall be posted at the on the BVBC Web site and at the Clubhouse by 1200 on Tuesday before the race.

7.0 VENUE & COURSES The race shall be held in the waters off San Francisco's Pier 54 between SF and Alameda. The course will be 10.9nm. All classes and divisions will sail the same course.

8.0 SCORING

8.1 Each Class and Division shall be scored separately for their division awards.

8.2 All Boats times shall be compared using PHRF Rules for the fastest boat overall award.

8.3 Any protest will be heard immediately after the race and only if involving boats that may receive a trophy. Any other protests shall be held on a separate date which time and date shall be posted on the BVBC Race Notice Board inside the Clubhouse by 1900 on the day of the race.

9.0 AWARDS The North Cup for fastest boat of the day on PHRF corrected time. There will be trophies for first for classes with five entrants, second if seven entrants, and third if nine entrants.

Concourse d'Elegance

Not Part of Race Notice of Race

Due to dock space constraints, ONLY boats entered in the Concourse shall tie up at the Bay View Boat Club for judging and to be viewed by public. Judging will be done between 1000 and 1600 by a committee from the Bay View Boat Club.

Awards will be presented for: The Prettiest Overall, Nicest Interior, Simplest to Single Hand, and Most "Stock" Boat.
